1 What is happening?

RE Resource Group and Ambrose Recruitment are merging to form a Group Structure. This will take effect from November 1st 2018

2 Why are we doing this?

Ambrose Recruitment and RE will continue to trade as separate limited companies but now under a Group structure, therefore existing Terms of Business, invoicing and banking arrangements will remain the same.
